Championship Classes (Sprint, Middle and Long)

M/W 10, 12A, 14A, 16A, 17- 20A, 21A, 35A, 45A, 55A, 65A, 75A

Non-Championship Classes

M/W Junior B (U21), Open B (Middle and Long only)

Awards:

There will no awards for the individual championships, but a competition will be conducted over the three events, with a maximum of 1,000 points being awarded per championship class using MT Points. The competitors with the highest points (scored in all three Championships) in each championship class will receive a commemorative coffee mug. Competitors must score points in all three Championships to be eligible for an award.

Entry Fees (GST included):

Sprint Distance:

Seniors \$18; Juniors (13-20) & concessions \$10; Sub-junior (U12) \$8. Family maximum \$50.

Middle Distance:

Seniors \$22; Juniors (13-20) & concessions \$12; Sub-junior (U12) \$10. Family maximum \$60.

Long Distance:

Seniors \$24; Juniors (13-20) & concessions \$14; Sub-junior (U12) \$12. Family maximum \$70.

Concessions include full-time undergraduate students and Seniors Cardholders.

Entries Closing Dates. Postal entries close (posted marked) on **Monday 4 May 2009** or **online Wednesday 6 May 2009**. Entries post-marked or submitted after those dates will be accepted only at the discretion of the organisers. **Enter-on-the-day** entries will only be accepted for the Middle and Long Distance Championships on three courses (Red 5, Orange 1, Green) on the basis that the entries are unofficial, with only one class per course, and full entry fee is paid. EOD competitors will start after all official competitors, and if no pre-marked maps are available EOD competitors will draw their course within their competition time. No EOD entries will be accepted after 2.00 pm Saturday or 10.30 am Sunday.
