

## Australian National Junior Coach

**Time Period:** December 2009 - end July 2011 with option of extension to end July 2012 subject to performance review

### **Job Requirements:**

- Coach the Australian Junior Squad and Junior World Championships team. This includes conducting and leading training and coaching of the squad/team, and liaise and provide technical assistance to the individual coaches and the squad/team members to assist in their development as orienteers.
- Provide leadership nationally on the development of competition, training and infrastructure to support and guide the development of Australia's best junior orienteers.
- As National Junior Coach, be a member of the High Performance Management Group and a leader in decision making related to the development of junior orienteering in Australia.
- Organise the conduct of at least one national training camp for the squad in each year that may utilise the services of the National Training Centre at ACTAS.
- Work with stakeholders in identifying junior orienteers who demonstrate both orienteering ability and physical ability to be future high performance orienteers.
- With the Junior Selection Panel, select the Junior World Championships Teams.
- Be an ex officio member of the OA Coaching Committee.
- Represent OA at national and international coaching meetings, workshops etc. as determined by mutual agreement with the Board.
- Liaise with the coaches of other representative teams with respect to the preparation of the Junior members of these teams.

### **Desired Skills/Experience:**

- Ideally a record of successful coaching of junior orienteers and/or junior orienteering teams/squads
- Appropriate Coaching qualifications.
- Any relevant experience in leading, managing and/or administering sporting groups.
- Proven high-level communication skills in working in both group environments and in one-on-one situations.

### **Remuneration:**

The position is voluntary in its nature. Funding is available to support squad/team activities and coach expenses in the conduct of the squad/team.
